

## NYSAFC Regional Hands-On Training – Flashover HOST REGISTRATION FORM

Training is held on two consecutive days. Each session is three hours. Multiple sessions will be held on each day. Each session includes a one-hour classroom presentation, followed by live fire training. There is no fee for hosting this program; however, each student will be charged \$100 per person (for NYSAFC Individual or Department members) or \$125 per person (non-members). Student registration form will be provided by NYSAFC. A minimum of 60 students will be trained during the two-day program. If minimum requirement of 60 students is not met, host organization(s) will be held responsible for the registration fee for each unfilled student training slot. Training will be scheduled based on availability of NYSAFC flashover training unit.

## Host Responsibilities:

- 72 sheets of OSB (1/2" or 7/16"). Provide receipt to NYSAFC within 30 days of training for reimbursement.
- 8-10 pallets.
- Classroom space for 15 students (minimum).
- A/V equipment (screen, projector, and sound system).
- Two engines with a total combined tank capacity of 1,000 gallons, or fire hydrant plus one Class A engine with 500 gallon tank, or two Class A engines with minimum 500 gallon tanks.
- SCBA refill (done nightly).
- Rehab (cases of water).
- EMS/BLS.
- Dumpster for burned material (minimum 10 cubic yards).
- Portable toilet or restroom.
- 20-pound propane tank.
