Host Registration Form

Training sessions are conducted over the course of two consecutive days (Saturday and Sunday). Each session is three hours, with multiple sessions held on each day. Each session includes a one-hour classroom presentation, followed by live fire training. There is no fee for hosting this training program; however, each student will be charged a registration fee of \$125 (NYSAFC Individual or Department members) or \$150 (non-members). A student registration form and flyer will be provided by NYSAFC. Student registration will be handled by NYSAFC staff. A minimum of 60 students must be trained over the course of the weekend program. If this minimum requirement is not met, the training program will be canceled and the host organization(s) will be charged a \$250 administrative fee. Training will be scheduled based on availability of the NYSAFC flashover training unit.

Type of Program:

- Closed Program (For host organization's members and invited guests only. Host is responsible for promotion of the program.)
- Open Program (Open enrollment. NYSAFC will assist with promotion of the program on the association's website and social media platforms and by a mailing to local fire departments. Host will assist with promotion locally by sharing announcements with area fire departments and county agencies/organizations.)

Host Responsibilities:

- 72 sheets of OSB (1/2" or 7/16"). Provide receipt to NYSAFC within 30 days of training for reimbursement.
- 8-10 pallets.
- Classroom space for 12 students.
- A/V equipment (screen, projector, and sound system).
- Two engines with a total combined tank capacity of 1,000 gallons, or fire hydrant plus one Class A engine with 500-gallon tank, or two Class A engines with minimum 500-gallon tanks.
- SCBA refill (done nightly).
- Rehab (cases of water).
- EMS/BLS.
- Dumpster for burned material (minimum 10 cubic yards).
- Portable toilet or restroom.
- Saw for cutting pallets and wood.
